

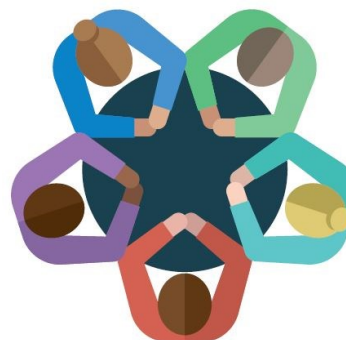
Who are we:
