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Dear Parent / Carers,

Well done to all children (and parent helpers!) on completing another week of home learning. We are seeing such fantastic work, hearing of such wonderful discussions and seeing great effort in everything the children are doing.

We would like to suggest a timetable for activities, as we are aware some children are trying to complete all activities set. In a normal classroom environment, we would end a maths lesson sometimes before every child had completed every question. We would therefore suggest following this timetable, and if you haven't finished an activity at the end of the allotted time, then handing it in and moving on to your next task. The Government require us to set a minimum of 3 hours home learning for KS1 children and 4 hours home learning for KS2 children.

We hope by providing this timetable it will help children to have some screen breaks, a morning break, lunch time and be finished before the usual end to the school day.

13:00 – 14:00	Topic themed activities
Friday (only)	R Time and Wellbeing time – Friday afternoon

13:15 – 14:15	Topic – Geography / PSHE / Music / PE etc.
14:15 – 14:30	Listen to class story
Friday (only)	Maths Science Reading activity / English activity R Time and Wellbeing time – Friday afternoon

We are of course aware, that not all children can complete their work in those set times, so please use the time given as a guidance for whenever you are able to complete the work set.

If your child finishes a task early, please encourage screen breaks e.g. running around in the garden, colouring, lego, reading amongst many other possibilities.

We hope this will help manage times for children, allowing them to complete tasks set, as well as knowing it is okay to hand in their best efforts in the time suggested.
